RE: Proposed Rule # 7

The Colorado Alliance of Mineral and Royalty Owners is a non profit all volunteer organization which represents and advocates for the interests of the state of Colorado's oil and gas mineral and royalty interest owners. CAMRO's membership is paid on over half of the states 54,000 oil and gas wells.

CAMRO's members well recognize that each statute rule and regulation passed by the state's legislature and the various agencies and commissions that have authority regarding the oil and gas industry ultimately affects the valuation of the property they own. This why each action taken to regulate must be necessary and scientifically sound. Unnecessary regulation devalues the asset and undermines the state interest.

It has been CAMRO's member's experience that industry has always answered the duty to be careful with the mineral asset that we entrust to their care. After all it is the industry's interest and the mineral - royalty owner interest to make sure that all of the product be efficiently developed without waste, and brought to market at the highest possible volume and price.

Overregulation, especially that which seeks to attain a result beyond which the industry has the capacity to resolve, such as ozone crossing Colorado's borders from other states or countries is not scientifically sound. CAMRO cannot support expanding Rule 7 state wide beyond its original scope.
